I. Criteria for admission to Fairleigh Dickinson University/University College: Arts • Sciences • Professional Studies Liberal Arts Programs

A. Minimum grade point average of 2.0, as determined by the Office of Admissions.

B. Specific course program criteria, if applicable.

Bergen Community College students who complete the program recommended in Appendix A will have met the General Education requirements at Fairleigh Dickinson University, with the exception of three “Core Requirements” (CORE 1006 The Global Challenge, CORE 2007 Perspectives on the Individual and COMM 4443 Ethics in the Media) General Education courses. The student will be required to complete these courses as part of the FDU degree.

History: 6 credits	Select two courses from BCC General Education History area.
Humanities: 18 credits	3 credits COM101 Mass Media of Communication 6 credits of one Foreign Language 9 credits from Fine Arts, Literature, Philosophy/Religion; No more than two courses from any area.
Social Science: 9 credits	Select three courses from at least two areas of BCC General Education Social Science areas.
Natural Science: 8 credits	Select two courses from BCC General Education Natural Science areas.
Mathematics: 3 – 4 credits	Approved Math courses: Choose one from MAT 130, 150, 155, 180, 250, or 280.
Computer Science Electives: 3 credits	Select one course from BCC General Education Computer Science area.
