

The following conditions, equivalencies and recommendations have been identified by the two institutions participating in this Agreement.

I. Criteria for admission to Pace University/Lubin School of Business

A. Minimum grade point average of 2.50, as determined by the Office of Admissions.

B. Specific course program criteria:

Bergen Community College students who complete one of the programs recommended in Appendices A - E will be prepared to enroll in junior-level major courses and can realistically expect to complete the Pace Bachelor of Business Administration Degree in 4-5 semesters. Students will prepare their academic plans with advisors in the Lubin School of Business

II. Course equivalencies and/or area requirements.

Specific course equivalencies have been determined and approved, and are indicated in the Appendices.

A minimum grade of C is required in all courses for the major.

III. Preferred course, program or degree options, including electives.

Associate in Science, Professional Studies, Business Administration degree options with the following degrees:

2. Other competencies/requirements/conditions:

BCC graduates who apply to Pace University under the terms of this agreement will have the admission application fee waived.

3. Upon enrollment at Pace, students from BCC who are admitted bearing the A.S. degree are eligible to receive financial aid, based upon financial need and or academic merit, on the same basis as any Pace student. Student must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA must be received by the Federal Student Aid office by February 15th each year.

Transfer students who have a 2.75 cumulative grade point average are eligible for Academic Scholarships and Grants. These awards range from \$4,000 to approximately \$10,000.

In addition to institutionally funded aid, students may qualify for need-based awards. Pace administers all Federal and State Financial Aid Programs.

B. Both Bergen Community College and Pace University agree to:

1. Monitor the academic performance of students enrolling under the agreement, identifying problems, and working cooperatively to adjust course sequence and content so that students can transfer with no academic disruptions;
2. Arrange transfer meetings to update major course equivalencies between Pace University and Bergen Community College;
3. Notify each other concerning any contemplated curricular changes which would affect the future of this agreement.
