Upon completion of the required pre-requisite and co-requisite courses, and successfully passing the NCLEX examination, you will then have the opportunity to transfer successfully earned Bridge Course Credits into Drexel's online RN to BSN program.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- High School diploma or equivalent
- First year completion of an Associate of Applied Science Nursing/Associate Degree in Nursing Program (or course equivalents) from an accredited institution (CCNE, NLN-AC, or ACEN)
- A minimum of 20 credit hours of college prerequisites, including English 101, from a regionally accredited institution, with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above

- NURS 324 Introduction to Online Learning: Tools for Success (3 credits)
- NURS 346 Health Assessment (6 credits)
- NURS 335 Genetics and Genomics (3 credits)
