Moodlerooms finished upgrading our server to version 3.2. As a result of this upgrade you will find some new features and functions added to our LMS.

So, what can you expect after the upgrade.

1. **Assignment Overrides:** Instructor can assign different submission start dates, due dates, and cut-off dates for different individuals and groups. Watch video tutorial on [User Overrides for Assignments](#).
2. **Assignment File type Restrictions:** Instructors can restrict the types of files students may submit to an assignment activity. When students edit their submissions, the file-picker only allows uploading accepted file types. Watch video tutorial on [Assignment File Type Restriction](#).
3. **Forum Locking:** Instructors can configure forums to lock after a period of inactivity within the forum. When a forum is locked students can't post or reply to the forum. Only instructors are able to post to the locked forum. This unlocks the forum and opens up discussions again. Watch video tutorial on [Discussion Locking](#).
4. **Course End Dates:** Instructors can now assign an end date to a course along with a start date. Course is unavailable to students after the last date.
5. **Checking Grades:** Students and Instructors can check grades, messages from the picture icon of the logged user.
6. **Moodlerooms Branding:** Advanced forums are now called Moodlerooms forums and Joule Grader is called Moodlerooms Grader and Dashboards are called Moodlerooms Reports. Gradbook is called Gradebook setup.
7. **Joule Gradebook:** No longer supported
