Group Study Rooms

About the Rooms

- The Library has six group study rooms located on the main level.
- Rooms are available for use to current BCC students doing collaborative work and study for course-related work.
- Minimum of 3 students per group are required to borrow a study room.
- Maximum of 8 students per group are permitted.
- Present a valid BCC student ID card to borrow a room.
- Rooms can be borrowed for 2 hours maximum.
- Rooms cannot be reserved, first come first serve.
- Rooms are not available for use by Faculty, Staff, BCCLS and the general public.

Group Study Room Guidelines for Use

- **Minimum of 3 students need to remain in the room at all times.**
- Please be considerate of other library users and **maintain reasonable noise levels.**
- Library furniture from other locations may not be moved into study rooms.
- The Library is not responsible for the loss or theft of personal property. **If you leave the room unattended, you risk the loss of your possessions.**
- **Groups are responsible for the condition of the room.** Leave the room clean and in good order for the next group of users, including erasing the white board.
- **Users are not allowed to sleep in these rooms.**
- **No Food is permitted in the group study rooms.**
- **Lights need to remain on for the duration of use.**
- At the end of the **2-hour loan period**, return the key promptly to the Service Desk.
- **Disruptive behavior or failure to follow guidelines will result in loss of borrowing privileges.**
